# ADIRONDACK MENNONITE CAMPING ASSOCIATION, INC.

## Membership Application Form

Any person in agreement with the objects of this Association shall be eligible for membership in this Association. Any member shall recognize and respect that the Association shall function with understandings represented by Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective (Summary statement is attached as an addendum to the By-laws).

Each member shall make an initial contribution to the Association of a minimum of \$300.00. Membership Certificates shall be issued upon payment of \$100.00 with the balance pledged to be paid within a period of not more than two years.

Such certificates may be issued either in the name of the member or in the name of the member and his wife or her husband as joint tenants with rights of survivorship. Wives or husbands shall be associate members in the Association. In the absence of a member at the meeting of the Association, the wife or husband may serve as proxy if he or she is personally present. Otherwise, associate members shall not be entitled to vote.

When a membership is terminated by death, the certificate representing his investment reverts to the association. A Member may withdraw from the Association by surrendering his or her certificate to the Association. The membership certificate shall be non-transferable with the exception that a wife or husband may exercise associate membership after the death of his or her spouse. A Member may be suspended for a period or expelled for cause such as violation of any of the by-laws or rules of the Association, or for conduct prejudicial to the best interest of the Association. Suspension or expulsion shall be by a two-thirds vote of the membership of the Board of Directors.

Membership is renewable annually by committing to support the Association in the year to come in accordance with options presented by the Board of Directors in the renewal notice.

Having read the above conditions of membership, I (we) wish to apply for membership in the Adirondack Mennonite Camping Association.
